The fund was established in 1968; it provides grants towards the expenses of research projects in the fields of botany or zoology by Fellows and Associates of the Society **who are not in full-time employment as biologists**. A committee appointed by Council administers the fund.

The deadline for applications is 31st March. Applications should consist of this form together with a one-page description of the project, and should give some estimate of costs. Short-listed applicants may be asked for additional information. All applicants will be informed of the outcome by the end of June.
